
South Africa's Greatest Golf Courses

<p>13 Nights, 2 on Safari | 11 Rounds</p>

The ultimate golf trip of South Africa, ticking off the very best courses and covering almost every corner of the country.

Start in the North on unique bushveld courses of Sun City and Leopard Creek, made famous after years of European Tour events. There is time to enjoy some safari drives at both locations before or after the golf each day. A short hop down to the coastal city of Durban for Durban Country Club, for decades the only course included in the original GOLF MAGAZINE Top 100. The trip remains on the East Coast of South Africa after a short flight to Port Elizabeth with Humewood, the only true links course on the continent of Africa. The golf remains of exceptional quality, with #6 ranked Montagu at Fancourt and the magnificent Links at Fancourt, ranked #1 in South Africa for a decade.

The cliff-top drama at Pinnacle Point is next on the list as you head towards the South Tip of Africa to Hermanus and Arabella GC. The trip ends at Pearl Valley, the Jack Nicklaus gem in the heart of the Cape Winelands.

This trip can be extended to include more touring or adapted in any way to connect to South Africa's safari destinations.

Saturday, January 1

This evening depart the United States.

Sunday, January 2

On arrival at Johannesburg Airport, you will be met by our VIP arrival assistant at the exit ramp of your aircraft. They will assist you through Immigration and Luggage Claims to your driver in the arrivals hall. If your schedule requires an additional internal connecting flight, you will be helped with check-in to that flight and you will be met by your driver after luggage claim in the arrivals hall of your second stop.

OVERNIGHT: **Palace of the Lost City** - 2 Luxury Room

Monday, January 3

Today play **The Lost City (tbc)**. The desert style design of the golf course has an exotic allure all of its own and designer, Gary Player has acknowledged it as one of his favorite courses. The Lost City Golf Course is flexible: playing off the forward tee a course length of 5953 meters, extending to 6983 meters off the back tee. The course provides spectacular views of the Palace Hotel and the neighboring game reserve. The most hazardous area of the Lost City Golf Course is the 13th hole. Inhabiting the water hazard are 38 Nile crocodiles, some of them nearly 14 ft long. Playing the back nine is like going on a golf safari. It has often been noted that the game is more exciting when played downhill and this is certainly the case here. In addition to the previously mentioned 13th, holes eleven, fourteen, fifteen and sixteen are all played from elevated tees offering thrill, excitement and challenge to the golfer.

And some of the most spectacular African views to be had on a golf course.

OVERNIGHT: **Palace of the Lost City** - 2 Luxury Room

Tuesday, January 4

Today play **Gary Player Country Club (tbc)**. Arguably South Africa's most famous course courtesy of its status as host of the Nedbank Golf Challenge and its position as the Top ranked course for 5 years. Situated in the crater of an extinct Volcano, the course cuts through the African bush and flanks a nature reserve, for 16 holes. Thick kikuyu rough and impenetrable bush punishes the wayward shot, so come armed with a good swing and a better brain. The course is blessed with superb greens that have recently been rebuilt and modernized with the bunkers.

Thursday, January 6

Today play **Leopard Creek (tbc)**. Situated near Malelane in the heart of Mpumalanga, on the southern border of the Kruger National Park, Leopard Creek presents a rare opportunity to play an outstanding bushveld golf course. The 360 hectare development is bordered to the north and the west by the picturesque Crocodile River and the Kruger National Park. Typical bushveld koppies overlook the course from the east, providing an ideal backdrop for a magnificent Gary Player designed course. Ranked #1 in South Africa in 2005, Leopard Creek is everything you would expect. The course is fairly remotely located and is therefore only recommended for clients looking to add a safari option in Southern Kruger or those using private air-charter services. (cart fee included)

Saturday, January 8

Today play **Durban CC (tbc)**. In any golfer's books, Durban Country Club rates as one of the finest courses in the world, let alone Africa, or even South Africa. The course lies adjacent to the beach onto which the Indian Ocean gently pushes its waves, separated only by a freeway linking the Northern suburbs with the city. It has a merry mix of tall trees, thick bush, severe slopes, undulating fairways that sometimes resemble rolling waves, and some very clever tee positions, with the ever penalizing bunkers lying in wait.

OVERNIGHT: **Beverly Hills Hotel** - 2 Standard Sea View Room

Sunday, January 9

Today play **Humewood (tbc)**. One of the world's most challenging links courses, Humewood is consistently ranked as one of South Africa's top golf courses. Found in the coastal city of Port Elizabeth, the golf course is a genuine seaside links, with wide and undulating fairways, fast greens and thick coastal bush. A round is a must for any golfer visiting Port Elizabeth. Tom Doak rates Humewood in his top 10 favourite Links courses worldwide.

OVERNIGHT: **St Francis Bay Lodge** - 2 Lodge Room

Monday, January 10

Play today at **St Francis Links (tbc)**. One of only 2 links courses found in Africa, St Francis Links is a Jack Nicklaus masterpiece situated on the coast, 1 hour South-West of Port Elizabeth at the end of the Garden Route. Jack himself describes the course as the best links course I have ever designed and he has outdone himself by combing the eyelash bunkers of Royal County Down and bent grass greens that provide a firm, slick putting surface. The course demands a wide range of shots as it is exposed to the elements and has undulating and often unpredictable terrain and firm fairway that roll across the natural dunes. It possesses an raw beauty that is both inspiring and challenging. A true links. The St Francis Links has been awarded "BEST NEW COURSE" (Golf Digest 2007) and "5 STAR GOLF EXPERIENCE" (Compleat Golfer 2007).

OVERNIGHT: **St Francis Bay Lodge** - 2 Lodge Room

Tuesday, January 11

Today play **Fancourt - The Montagu (tbc)**. Designed by Gary Player and remodeled in 2004 by David McKay-Kidd (Bandon Dunes), the Montagu is South Africa's best parkland golf course. With the highest levels of conditioning and true championship layout, The Montagu at Fancourt sets the standards by which all other courses in South Africa are measured.

OVERNIGHT: **Fancourt Hotel** - 2 Luxury Room

Wednesday, January 12

Today play **Fancourt - The Links (tbc)**. **Ranked #1** in South Africa. Created from a previously flat piece of land, over 700 000 cubic metres of earth was moved in transforming it into a typical Links style. The course presents undulating windswept terrain and dune-style landscape and is the only such course in South Africa. Every hole has received detailed attention to ensure that the overall balance in terms of length, position of hazards and shot values are in harmony. As a result, The Links presents a stern test in all weather conditions. This is a walking course with caddies. Host course of the 2003 Presidents Cup, 2005 Women's World Cup and 2006 South African Open. Carts and caddies are available.

OVERNIGHT: **Fancourt Hotel** - 2 Luxury Room

Thursday, January 13

Today play **Pinnacle Point (tbc)**. Magnificently perched atop staggering cliffs, this windswept course three hours east of Cape Town and a half hour south of George marks a major addition to South Africa's already world-class golf scene. Six of the holes play across deep chasms to greens that seem to float in the Indian Ocean. The yawning ravines and distant horizons can make 150-yard shots look like twice that length. On the par-four eighth, tee and green sit on opposing bluffs; big hitters can attempt an all-or-nothing carry with the hope of having an easy wedge in, or play it safe by bailing out left and facing a much longer approach. Throughout the layout, the architects wisely designed large, fairly flat greens that yield plenty of sensible pin placements and give golfers who have run a gauntlet just to get to the green a bit of a break. OVERNIGHT: **Arabella Western Cape Hotel & Spa** - 2 Deluxe Room

Friday, January 14

Today play **Arabella (tbc)**. Ranked no. 5 in South Africa in 2005, Arabella is perfectly designed to exploit its unique position alongside the largest natural lagoon in Southern Africa. The 8th, 9th, 17th and 18th holes run parallel to the lagoon, proving a truly memorable experience. Choosing a signature hole proves to be an extremely difficult task as all of the holes are well designed with spectacular views. The course is the host course to the Nelson Mandela Invitational, Africa's premier Pro-am Charity Event. (cart fee included)

OVERNIGHT: **Arabella Western Cape Hotel & Spa** - 2 Deluxe Room

Saturday, January 15

Play today at **Pearl Valley (tbc)**. Set in the famous Franschhoek Wine region, this new Jack Nicklaus Signature Course is a treat to play. Pearl Valley is probably in the top conditioned course in South Africa. As with many Nicklaus courses, water on the right with plenty of sand, will keep the golfers mind off the wide landing areas provided. Also a new development, the course and its geographical location allow for guests to enjoy a day outing in the Winelands with high quality golf to compliment the food and wine. A second course, 'Bears Best' will be built shortly on the same property. (cart fee included)

OVERNIGHT: **Table Bay Hotel** - 2 Luxury King Room
